FACTS	What does Ameliora Wealth Management Ltd. (Ameliora) do with your personal information?
Why ?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires Ameliora to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What ?	<p>Ameliora limits the use, collection, and retention of client information to what we believe is necessary or useful to conduct our business, provide quality service, and offer products, services and other opportunities that may be of interest to you. Information collected may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identification data, e.g., names, addresses, telephone numbers, Social Security Number; - Financial information, e.g. bank details; - Transaction/investment data, e.g., current and past investments, investment profile, investment preferences and invested amount, number and value of shares held, role in a transaction (seller/acquirer of shares), transaction details; <p>The above referenced information is collected at the inception of your relationship with Ameliora. Thereafter, we will contact you periodically to review your overall account holdings, and to ensure that personal information contained in your file is accurate. Please review any information provided to you related to your account and notify Ameliora promptly on the discovery of erroneous information.</p> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
How ?	All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information, the reasons Ameliora chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Ameliora protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with Federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Ameliora collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Open an account or enter into an investment advisory contract - Seek advice about your investments - Make deposits or withdrawals from your account(s) - Give us your income information or employment history <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as affiliates or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness - Affiliates from using your information to market to you - Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account—unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions	
Affiliates	<p><i>Companies related by common ownership or control. Our affiliates include:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Nonfinancial companies such as GN Treuhand Anstalt and First Advisory Group, and</i> - <i>Financial companies such as GN Finance AG.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p><i>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Ameliora does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	<p><i>A formal agreement between companies that, together, market products to you.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>Ameliora does not jointly market.</i>
